2014 MARINE KID's FISHING DERBY

SITE OF DERBY:	War in the Pacific Historical Park, Asan.
DERBY DATES:	June 21, 2014 and August 02, 2014. Participants may register for one derby date.
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:	Any child from 7 to 12 years old. Participants must be seven years old and not have reached their thirteenth birthday by the date of the derby.
PROOF OF AGE:	Provide original birth certificate, passport, military or Guam picture ID when registering. Faxed copies will NOT be accepted.
SAFETY BRIEFING:	All participants <u>MUST</u> attend the 20-minute Safety Briefing, which will begin at 7:30am on the derby day.
DERBY DATE SCHEDULE:	Mandatory Safety Briefing begins at 7:30am. Fishing Competition Time is from 8am - 10am Awards Ceremony from 10am – 12pm.
REGISTRATION DEADLINE:	Registration is ongoing from 8am – 5pm, weekdays at the DAWR Admin Office in Mangilao, across from Price Elementary School on Dairy Road. The deadline for registration is June 18, 2014 for the first derby, and July 30, 2014 for the second derby date, OR when the limit of seventy-five (75) participants for each date has been met. A registration will be considered incomplete and therefore ineligible for consideration if proof of the child's age is not provided by the registration deadline.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- A maximum of seventy-five (75) participants per fishing day will be accommodated. Participants may select which date they prefer. If the number of registrants exceeds the number of available slots, the first 75 registrants/per date will participate in the Derby. Seventy-five participants per day ensures that there is adequate shoreline for fishing and safety requirements.
- Derby participants must provide the name of the adults who will accompany and remain with the participant throughout the Derby. Substitute guardians are permitted provided the substitute's name and signature are on the registration form. Participants who show up unaccompanied by a guardian or parent will not be able to participate.
- Access to the fishing site will be limited only to the participant and their registered parents or guardians. One guardian may accompany a maximum of two participants. Participant may bring a maximum of two adult guardians. Other guests must stay away from the beach area to avoid interfering or being injured by the fishing activity.
- The accompanying parent or guardian must remain with the participant at all times. If a parent or guardian escorts two participants, they must stay together throughout the event.
- The actual Fishing Competition will begin at 8AM and conclude at 10AM.
- **THIS IS A CATCH AND RELEASE DERBY: ALL FISH CAUGHT MUST BE RELEASED AFTER BEING MEASURED.** Any expired fish must immediately be turned over to derby officials.
- Each participant **MUST** provide the following:
 - 1) A hand line or fishing rod and reel—only hook and line fishing is allowed.

DAWR recommends light weight fishing tackle with 10-15 lbs. test line or less. It is recommended that the fishing rod be flexible and not too large or heavy for the child to handle comfortably and safely for the two-hour event. Extra line and scissors should be brought.
 - 2) Fishing Tackle: Participants must provide their own fishing tackle, including hooks, sinkers, and floaters. Tackle to intentionally snag fish is prohibited. Participants are encouraged to bring a needle-nose plier or hook removers to more easily remove hooks from the fish.
 - 3) Bait: Participants must bring their own bait. chumming is **NOT** allowed during the fishing derby.
- Participants must do all the casting, reeling and landing of the fish by themselves. The adult may assist with baiting the hook, removal of fish from the hook or lure once the fish has been landed by the participant, fixing tackle, and perform any action required to

ensure the well being and safety of the participant. The adult is restricted from any action involving the catching and landing the fish.

- Participants and their guardians are not to enter the water at any time or under any circumstances.
 - The use of landing nets, using more than one pole per participant, multiple hooks per fishing pole, and using live bait are not allowed.
 - Participants and guardians are advised to wear light colored long-sleeved cotton t-shirts, light colored long pants, shoes, a hat, sunglasses, use sun block for skin protection, and bring a basic first aid kit. An umbrella and raincoat should be brought in the event of rain. Gloves should be used for handling the fish.
 - Drinks, preferable water, and snacks should also be brought. Agriculture will provide some refreshments.
 - Awards will be presented immediately following each day's event. All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation marking their participation in the derby. Winners for the fishing categories will be presented with their prize at the awards ceremony.
 - For each fishing day, there shall be three (3) categories of winners—**MOST FISH, LONGEST FISH** and **LONGEST TRIGGERFISH** caught. Eels will not be considered for any of the categories and must immediately be released by cutting the participant's fishing line.
 - The top three (3) finishers in each category will be eligible for a prize.
 - Each participant is allowed only one prize.
 - If there are more prizes than qualifiers, the remaining prizes will be awarded via a lottery system.
 - In case of a tie in the categories, angler placing will be determined by the time of capture of the last qualifying fish.

- **LONGEST FISH:** the earliest time for the "last longest fish" wins.
 - **MOST FISH:** the earliest time for the "last fish caught" wins.
 - **LONGEST TRIGGERFISH:** the earliest time for the "longest triggerfish caught" wins.
